

1. Nature of work :-Operation Muskan 2017.
2. Police station/Branch and district :- Women Cell, Amravati City.
3. Date of good work done:- 01/07/2017 To 31/07/2017

By the orders of Respected Director General of Police M.S Mumbai, Amravati Police Commissionerate launched 'Operation Muskaan' effectively and successfully from dt. 1/07/2017 to dt. 31/07/2017 along with the coordination of Child Welfare Committee and the media. 'The Children Police Squad' constituted at Police Commissionerate level and sorted out the slum areas, railway stations, bus depot, religious places in the limits of Police Commissionerate. The related information was noted down and the search operation was initiated. The information regarding children was collected from various places, they were taken into confidence and after enquiring, during the investigation 28 girls and 66 boys, in all 94 children were searched.

While searching for the children on record all the Investigation Officers were called with their Case diary. They were instructed to keenly examine the crime from the year 2013 to 2017 and enquire the witnesses, relatives and other friends and take them into confidence. The Investigation Officers immediately began the enquiry and the information that was received was grouped accordingly and the further investigation started.

For searching the victim in the case P.S Kotvali CR. No. 265/2014 Section 363 I.P.C, the relatives were enquired and it was revealed that the accused shifting from one place to another instead of staying in the same place so that he and the victim couldn't be traced. Police didn't stop chasing them for continuously 3 years. When the accused came to know that he was being searched by the police time to time, he approached an advocate. He submitted the bail application in

the Hon'ble court. As soon as the police got clue about this, they chased the accused and successfully found the victim. The victim was safely given into the custody of her parents.

In this way, having searched for other children on the record, the girl victims were found from the following cases 1) CR. No.318/17 Section 363 I.P.C 2) CR. No.534/17 Section 363 I.P.C from P.S Frejarpura 3) CR. No.13/17 Section 363 I.P.C from P.S Badnera 4) CR. No. 868/16 Section 363 I.P.C 5)CR. No.312/16 Section 363 I.P.C from P.S Gadge Nagar.

In this way, during 'Operation Muskaan', 6 girls on the record, 28 girls and 66 boys other than the record, thus in all 100 children were searched. Among those 100 children, 99 children were given in the custody of their parents along with the help of Child Welfare Committee and the media and 1 girl is in the custody of The Child Welfare Committee.
